

Instruction for safe use:

Quick hitch concrete bucket

Safety First:

The following instructions must be read and understood by each intended user of this equipment; if there is anything you do not understand contact Eichinger Equipment Ltd.

Ensure the equipment is adequate for the job you need to carry out.

You must not operate this equipment if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or if you are feeling unwell.

A risk assessment should be carried out prior to moving or using this equipment.

The following PPE (Personal protective equipment) should be worn when using this equipment:

Gloves / Goggles / Hard Hat / Steel Toecap boots / Hi-Vis Vest

We also suggest suitable clothing should be worn.

Familiarise yourself with the equipment, its use and how it works!

Ensure the intended area for use is clear of overhead cables and power lines or similar hazards which may affect its safe use.

This equipment must always be used in conjunction with your site safety policies!

Using the equipment:

Choose the correct pin size to suite the machine you are using

Install front pin in to correct position on attachment

Ensure the rear pin is located correctly to suite your quick hitch. Follow your quick hitch operator guidelines to set the pins to maximum centres for the unit being used.

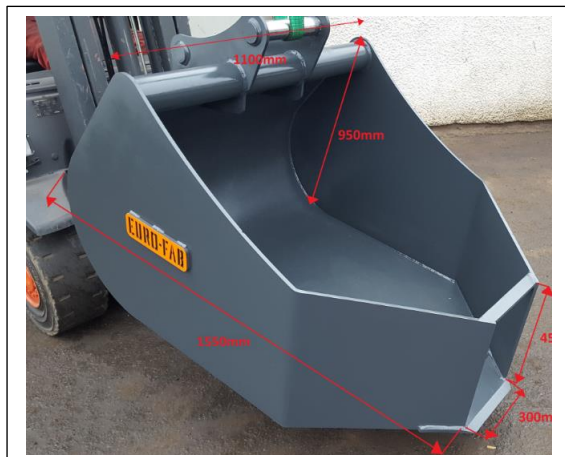
Place the retaining bolts in to the pins to secure the in place

Clear the quick hitch of debris. Attach the unit to the quick hitch and ensure the fit is safe and secure. Do not use if the unit is not secure!

With the bucket raised off the ground track to the concrete lorry for loading positioning the bucket under the discharge point of the lorry.

Tilt the unit backwards during filing.

Track to the desired location and discharge the bucket by tilting forwards.



The equipment noted here should always be used in line with the load rating of the machine it is attached to.

Prior to use confirm that the area is adequate for the intended work and is clear of any hazards, obstructions or personnel.

Ensure hands and feet are clear of the unit during use to avoid any crush risk.

Prior to each use this item should be visually inspected by a competent person as well as inspected in line with on site risk assessments or safe working practices

At the end of each use, ensure the unit is cleaned and stored in a safe, secure location and is ready for its next use.

REMEMBER

Read and understand these instructions prior to use. If you have any questions or uncertain about the use of this product then contact the manufacturer.

Always ensure that all aspects of the job you intend to carry have been considered and that the equipment is suitable.

It is your responsibility to ensure the safety of yourself, colleagues and the general public whilst using this equipment
